A great chance to see inside this grand and imposing building and imagine it as the 18th/19th century home of the Seymour family - great entrepreneurs who founded Odiham's first bank. Also an opportunity for those who attended Danetree School to rekindle memories of that era when the grounds stretched to the Cemetery.

2.30pm THE DEER PARK

Derek Spruce will lead a guided walk along the footpaths covering Odiham's Historic Royal Deer Park, beginning from the Bridewell. Dress according to weather.
